ORDINANCE 7-6-2011

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY INTO CASTLE DALE CITY,  
AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the Castle Dale City Council received a petition to annex certain real property described herein on June 7, 2011; and

**WHEREAS**, the petition for annexation has been accepted by resolution of the Castle Dale City Council and certified by the Castle Dale City Recorder in accordance with law; and

**WHEREAS**, a notice of the proposed annexation has been published and sent to affected entities; and

**WHEREAS**, no protests have been received from property owners or effected entities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Castle Dale City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City and its residents to annex the area proposed for annexation and that the City is capable of providing municipal services to the area.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of Castle Dale City Council as follows:

**Section 1. PURPOSE**

The purpose of this ordinance is to annex certain real property into Castle Dale City in response to a valid petition from owners of private land within the area proposed for annexation that is at least one-half the value of all the private land in the proposed annexation and that covers a majority of the land proposed for annexation

**Section 2. CLASSIFICATION**

This is a non-code ordinance

**Section 3. GENERAL PROVISIONS**

Pursuant to the receipt of a valid petition, certification by the Castle Dale City Recorder, acceptance by the Castle Dale City Council and th completion of all statutory requirements prescribed by Utah State law, the following described real property is hereby annexed into the City of Castle Dale.

Beginning at a point which is 28.94 feet West of the Northeast corner of the Northwest quarter of Section 3, Township 19 South, Range 8 East, SLB&M, said point being on the existing Castle Dale City Boundary; thence West, 491.56 feet along said City Boundary; thence South, 165.00 feet; thence East, 495.26 feet more or less to the west right-of-way line of County Road; thence N 1°17'01" W, 165.04 feet along said right-of-way to the point of beginning.

Containing 1.87 Acres more or less.





ORDINANCE ANNEXING SPECIFIC  
PROPERTY TO CLAWSON, UT

WHEREAS, a majority of not less than one-third of the owners of real property described below have petitioned this municipality for annexation; and

WHEREAS, said real property is an unincorporated area contiguous to the boundaries of Clawson Town and the annexation thereof will not leave or create an unincorporated island or peninsula; and

WHEREAS, the petition was accompanied by an accurate plat or map of the territory to be annexed prepared under the supervision of a licensed surveyor or engineer; and

WHEREAS, the petition and map have been filed in the office of the municipal recorder; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council held the required public hearing after giving notice as required by law, and has determined annexation of said property is appropriate and desirable;



**WHEREAS**, a majority of the owners of certain real property described below, desire to annex such real property to Ferron, Emery County, Utah, said owners being the owners of at least one-third (1/3) in value of said real property as shown by the last assessment roll; and

**WHEREAS**, said real property consists of approximately 2.036 acres and lies contiguous to the corporate boundaries of Ferron, Utah; and

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


